An international association sought to develop a new growth strategy. The board, consisting of 12 members with diverse perspectives, faced challenges in finding common ground.

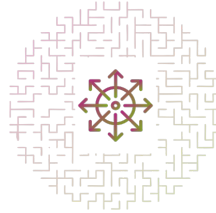
## Goals and Metrics

- Strategy Development:** Utilized voice-to-text, sentiment and semantic analysis to process and analyse interview data, using state-of-the-art LLMs.
- Implementation Plan:** Analysed the text corpus to extract implicit idea snippets and display areas of consensus and disagreement.
